NRECA's Business and Technology Strategies provides a variety of reporting available online, including:

- **Reports and Whitepapers** in-depth examination of a topic

- **Advisories** relatively quick reporting on newsworthy topics



In recent years, BTS has produced between 50 to 80 articles and advisories annually for our members. Summaries of this output can be found online, with links to each article, for your convenience.


