Smart Thermostats for Smart DR

Finalists for XPRIZE CO₂ Challenge Announced

Ten finalists have been selected by the NRG COSIA Carbon XPRIZE and each is taking home an equal share of a \$5 million milestone prize. This was revealed April 9 at the Bloomberg New Energy Finance's Future of Energy Summit in New York City. The finalists are developing innovative technologies for converting CO₂ into useful products. Five who are focused on CO₂ from coal power plants will be testing at the Integrated Test Center at Basin Electric's Dry Fork Plant in Gillette, WY; and five who are focused on CO₂ from natural gas fired power plants will be testing in Alberta, Canada.
