Recognizing that building a fiber broadband network would bring economic opportunities and quality of life necessities to the sparsely populated Western Slope of Colorado, Delta-Montrose took initiative to create its non-profit entity, Elevate Fiber, to build the fiber network and expand services to its members. 


Second Opportunity for Members to Take SANS Cybersecurity Courses for Free
