The Program's Vision

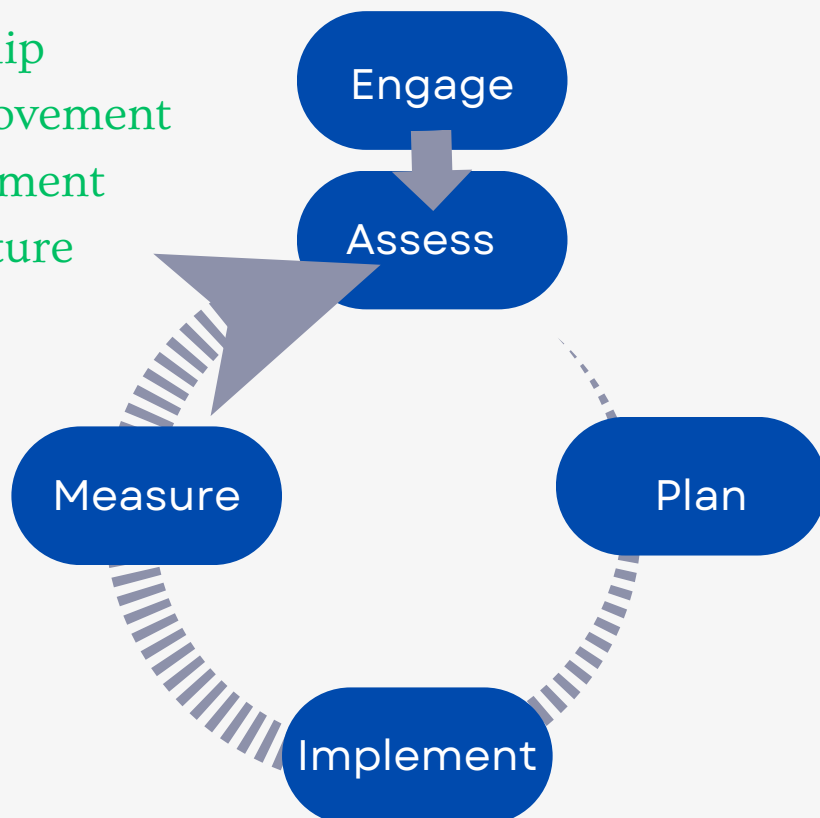
The purpose of the RESAP program is to assist cooperatives in continually evaluating their current state of safety performance and creating a continuous safety improvement process that if effectively applied, will better enable co-ops to reduce injuries over time.

Approach & Structure

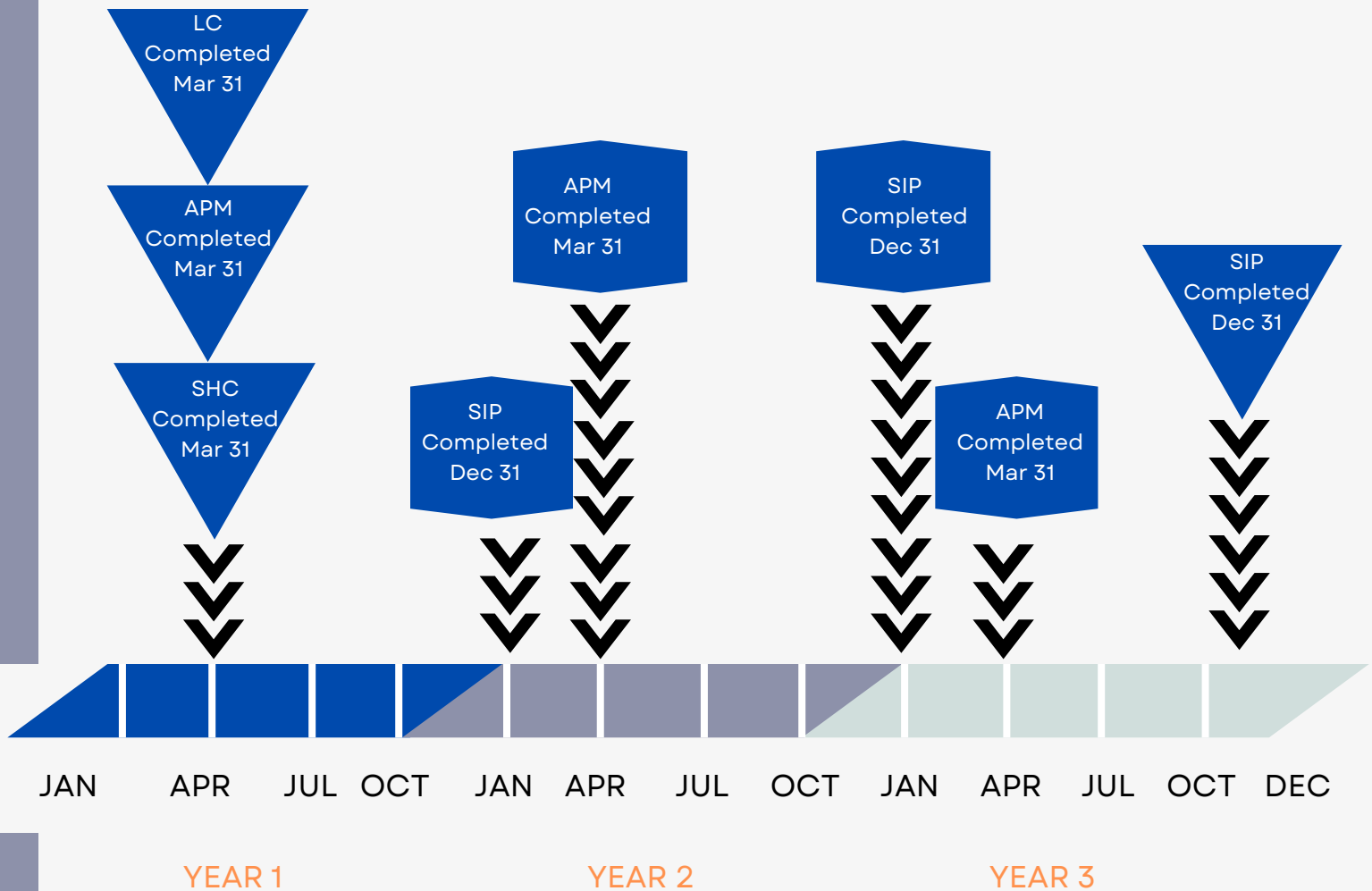
The goal of the program is to assist co-ops in creating a continuous safety improvement process that includes the following key components:

- A leadership commitment – to add focus to the importance of leadership engagement.
- An onsite safety assessment – conducted once every three years by a team of trained observers (peer-to-peer review) – to provide an objective assessment of strengths and opportunities for improvement.
- Creation of an annual safety improvement plan – to provide a structured approach to manage ongoing improvement activities by involving employees
- Collection of safety performance data – to provide an understanding of ongoing progress and trends in performance.
