Approach & Structure

The goal of the program is to assist co-ops in creating a continuous safety improvement process that includes the following key components:

• A leadership commitment – to add focus to the importance of leadership engagement.

• An onsite safety assessment - conducted once every three years by a team of trained observers (peer-to-peer review) – to provide an objective assessment of strengths and opportunities for improvement.


• <u>Creation of an annual safety improvement plan</u> – to provide a structured approach to manage ongoing improvement activities by involving employees
