

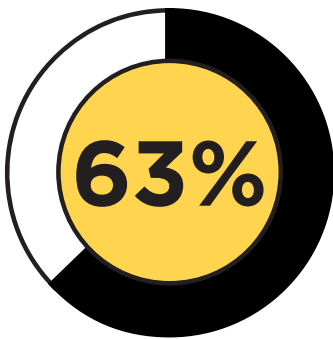
Co-op Members Are Politically Active

POLITICAL ENGAGEMENT BEHAVIORS

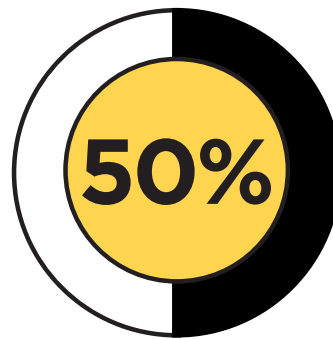
Co-op consumer-members show strong involvement in the political process, including an increase in contacts with elected officials about a co-op issue.
